

Shuji Miyagawa, MD, PhD

After graduating at Hokkaido University Medical School, he finished clinical training in the 1st Department of Surgery, Osaka University Medical School. He obtained his PhD from the same University in 1989, by The Mechanism of Discordant Xenograft Rejection. He worked at University of Texas Medical School in Houston as a Research Associate from 1988-1990. He became an Assistant Professor in 1995, and Associate Professor at Osaka University in 1998 - 2019. Visiting researcher at Research Institute for Microbial Diseases Osaka University from 2019. Visiting Professor at Meiji University International Institute for Bio-Resource Research from 2018.

His works have been presented in numerous international meetings, especially international Xenotransplantation Association (IXA), and he held the IXA-2013 in Osaka as the president. He was a councilor of IXA from 2013 – 17 and 2019 - now, and the president of Japanese Society for Xenotransplantation (JSX) from 2013 to now.
